## Ethics Policy

- knowingly support segregation of its workforce on any grounds including, gender, religion, race, sexual orientation, nationality.
- knowingly exploit local labour markets to the detriment of local employees.

Atomic80 will;

- pay a fair and reasonable wage having regard of the local labour market, skills employed, working conditions and national or local minimum wage levels.
- ensure, so far as is reasonably practicable, its workforce is adequately trained to undertake its duties in a professional, safe and efficient manner.
